The goals of the UTC Art Award for Equity and Inclusion are to highlight the importance of diversity and inclusion and support the efforts of those who have been underrepresented to feel welcome at SECAC 2019.

Those who have been underrepresented in their field (due to race, gender, ethnicity, religion, national origin, age, disability, or veteran status) and those whose scholarship promotes equity and inclusion should feel welcome to apply.

This award helps to offset the costs of attending the SECAC 2019 conference. We will grant five awards at \$200 each. Award recipients are chosen by an ad-hoc awards committee of UTC Faculty, convened by the conference co-directors. Applicants must be current SECAC 2019 selected conference participants, chairs, presenters, or juried exhibition artists.

Applicants must submit a statement (no more than 250 words) which explains how their participation furthers the goals of this award, as stated above. Applications will be judged on the quality of this written statement. Submit this statement and your CV to Conference Co-Directors Katie Hargrave and Christina Vogel at secac2019@gmail.com.
